With matching funds from legacy donors Pam Bergman and Laura Fox, we aim to raise \$500,000 over five years for the Vision & Action Fund dedicated to driving growth and ensuring P.S. ARTS' enduring position as a leader in public education equity and transformation.

How is the Vision & Action Fund different from other major gift opportunities?

Beyond maintaining the status quo, the Vision & Action Fund is reserved entirely for service innovation and pilot projects that significantly increase P.S. ARTS' earned income, sustainable growth, and capacity to be a powerful social change-driver in California and the United States.

As an example, in 2021, a \$50,000 investment from the P.S. ARTS Vision & Action Fund in Teaching Artist development led to hiring more than a dozen new Teaching Artists and allowed the organization to accept more than \$250,000 in public funding contracts, providing arts programs for 10,000 more children in high-need school districts.
